


MEETING NOTICE: SUNDAY, MARCH 22, 2014 at 11:00AM

Topic: HIDDEN GENEALOGICAL RESOURCES: THE COURTS' PAPERS, NOTARY BOOKS AND POLICE FUNDS AT UKRAINIAN ARCHIVES (1800-1930)

The main goal of this presentation is to provide the different kinds of Jewish genealogical sources of information that are hidden in the documents of a large number of different Russian Empire state agencies, including:

- > The Courts (local, criminal, administrative, military):
- Notary offices (with the detailed description of wills or real estate purchasing by Jews all over the territory of the modern Ukraine);
- > Police funds (including local militia, criminal cases and anti-spy secret services)

All the materials used in this presentation were collected by real work at the Ukrainian archives and provide the opportunity to understand the importance of revealing such documents at Jewish Genealogy research process.
